


1 Introduction

This document specifies the proposed format for the Comma Separated Variable (CSV) file to be used for the electronic submission of sales notes.

2 Data Delivery

2.1 Naming Conventions

The CSV files should be named in accordance with the following convention.

<Originator ID><Date><Time>.CSV

Where

- Originator ID is the registered ID of the organisation generating the submission
- Date is the date of submission in the format YYYYMMDD
- Time is the time of submission in the format HHMM

Note, The date and time in the filename should be specified in GMT.

Example file name

29200811171730.CSV

2.2 Delivery Address

The CSV files should be sent as an attachment to an email to the address specified on the national authority ERS website.

2.3 Subject Line

The subject line of the sent email should match one of the two following forms.

ERS – Email submission of CSV file - Originator ID

eSalesNote

2.4 Acknowledgements

Each email with CSV attachment will be acknowledged by a return email. See section 5 of this document for details of the acknowledgement email.

3 File Definition

3.1 Overview

The CSV files shall hold data for a submission of either a Buyers' Sales Note or a Sellers' Sales Note. Each file will consist of a number of distinct lines of different types. The available line types are

- Identification Line
- Submission Line
- Originator/Vessel Details
- Sales Data
- Logbook & Landing Declaration Numbers
- Sales Lines (Buyers Sales Note)
- Sales Line (Sellers Sales Note)

3.2 Line Types

3.2.1 *Identification Line*

This line shall identify the details of the originating system.

3.2.2 *Submission Line*

The submission line shall identify the type of data present and the reason for the submission.

3.2.3 *Originator/Vessel Details*

This line shall identify the originator of the CSV file and the vessel to which the data applies.

3.2.4 *Sales Data*

This line details the basic sales data, e.g. date, port etc.

3.2.5 *Logbook & Landing Declaration Numbers*

The file will contain a number of lines detailing any applicable logbook and landing declaration numbers

3.2.6 *Sales Line (Buyers Sales Note)*

This sales line will identify all of the details applicable to the buyers' sales note.

3.2.7 *Sales Line (Sellers Sales Note)*

This sales line will identify all of the details applicable to the sellers' sales note.

3.3 Line Fields and Formats

The following tables identify the fields to be included in each of the defined line types. All fields are mandatory (M) unless otherwise stated. Conditional (C) and Optional (O) fields may be left blank.

4 CSV File Characteristics

4.1 File Size

It is acceptable to include multiple sales notes in one CSV file. In this case each Sales note must conform to the File Composition rules above and each new sales note in the file will start with an identification line e.g.

5 Acknowledgments

Acknowledgement emails will be sent in response to emails received by the ERS. The acknowledgement emails will have a CSV file attached that will include a response line for each of the sales notes in a CSV submission.

5.1 Naming Conventions

The CSV files will be named in accordance with the following convention.

<Originator ID><Date><Time>_RES.CSV

Where

- Originator ID is the registered ID of the organisation generating the submission
- Date is the date of submission in the format YYYYMMDD
- Time is the time of submission in the format HHMM

Note, The date and time in the filename should be specified in GMT.

Example file name

29200811171730_RES.CSV

5.2 Subject Line

In the response emails the subject line will match one of the two following forms:

ERS – Email response to CSV file - Originator ID

ERS-Email response to CSV file-eSalesNote

5.3 Response Line

Note: The sales line cross-reference check validates the combination of species, freshness, presentation, state and size. Details of the allowed combinations are available from the Port Office Authorities.

5.4 File Composition

In order to simplify the process of matching the responses to the sales notes the returned file will also contain some of the data from the original file. An example is provided in section 6.2.

5.5 Corrections

When supplying corrections the Sales Note ID of the original submission must be included on the submission line as the last field. An example is provided in section 6.1.3

5.6 Error Messages

The table below describes the error message that might be received in the acknowledgments to sales note submissions. Note %d and %s indicate where data will be inserted into the messages.
